THIS CHANGE LED TO GREATER STABILITY BUT ALSO RESULTED IN THE LOSS OF CITIZEN PARTICIPATION IN GOVERNMENT AND THE CONCENTRATION OF POWER IN THE HANDS OF A SINGLE INDIVIDUAL. THIS TRANSITION IMPACTED THE SOCIAL STRUCTURE, MILITARY ORGANIZATION AND EVENTUALLY THE COLLAPSE OF THE EMPIRE.
