Apple already announced some improvements to Siri, for instance Siri will, with iOS 6, be able to start applications. But it's hardly expected to be contextually aware in any real way. Ask Siri "what is my favorite gas station?" Siri answers "I don't know." The problem is, that isn't really true. Apple knows what gas stations I'm most likely to stop at. Or it could, if it just knew how to contextually evaluate the data that both Verizon and Apple already have streaming from my phone. If it doesn't know something like my favorite gas station, it certainly doesn't know the answer to something simple like "how many times do I eat at Chinese restaurants?" That's easily verifiable. Ask it such a question and it just brings up a list of Chinese restaurants near you. It doesn't even try to accurately turn down the question. But back to Jobs.
