HIS WORK SPARKED DEBATE ABOUT THE NATURE OF DEMOCRACY AND THE POTENTIAL FOR COLLECTIVE ACTION.

MONTESQUIEU'S THE SPIRIT OF THE LAWS: MONTESQUIEU'S CONTRIBUTION LIES IN HIS ANALYSIS OF DIFFERENT FORMS OF GOVERNMENT AND HIS EMPHASIS ON THE SEPARATION OF POWERS. HIS IDEAS, ADVOCATING FOR A BALANCE OF POWER AMONG
